Do I need a ticket? No, but we do strongly recommend that you RSVP on our website. Anyone who RSVPs online will be granted early access to the island—giving you the first pick of spots to sit.

Is this a family friendly event? Absolutely! This is a comic musical operetta by Gilbert and Sullivan, great fun for all ages.

Will there be seating available? Chairs will be available ONLY for patrons who have purchased either the \$25 or \$50 ticket option. Free admission patrons are welcome to bring their own lawn chair or blanket to enjoy the show.

Will there be food? Food trucks will be available on site or you can pack a picnic..

Can we bring alcohol on the island? No, Raspberry Island is a public park; no alcohol is allowed to be brought on the island. If you'd like to enjoy two glasses of champagne during the performance, we suggest you purchase a \$50 VIP ticket where champagne is included in your experience.

How long will the performance be? The performance is approximately 90 minutes long.

Parking? : Raspberry Island is Handicap parking only, with approved state decal on display. Additional parking can be found in two lots located along Harriet Island Road. There is also a paid parking lot (called Trans Park off of East Harriet Island Road and East Fillmore Avenue) and a parking ramp at East Fillmore Ave. and S. Robert St. available.

ASL Interpretation? Available for one performance—Sunday, June 25 at 2:00 p.m.

What happens if it rains? Depending on how severe the weather is, the show may be moved to Central Presbyterian Church. We encourage everyone who attends, whether as free or paid admission, to RSVP in order to receive an email notification in case of rain. Rain notifications will also be posted across all of our social media channels. If it is just light rain, the show will go on as planned.
