

DIRECTIONS TO RASPBERRY ISLAND AND PARKING INFO

From the West: Take I-94 East to 5th Street exit into downtown. Follow 5th Street to St. Peter St. and turn right. Follow to Kellogg Blvd. Turn left on Kellogg and immediately turn right on Wabasha Street Bridge (the bridge with the rainbow flags on it). Follow the bridge over to the West Side, turn left onto Fillmore Avenue, and then turn left on Harriet Island Boulevard (look for the showboat sign). As you begin to follow Harriet Island Boulevard, begin looking for parking as you pass the Trans Park parking lot. Keep driving on Harriet Island Boulevard and you will see the parking lots available for parking.

From the East: Take I-94 West to W Lafayette Frontage Rd/US Hwy 52 in St. Paul. Take the exit to Plato Blvd. from US Hwy 52. Take Plato Blvd., S. Robert St., and East Fillmore Avenue to Raspberry Island.

From the North: Take I-35 E South to W Lafayette Frontage Rd/US Hwy 52 in St. Paul. Take the exit to Plato Blvd. from US Hwy 52. Take Plato Blvd., S. Robert St., and East Fillmore Avenue to Raspberry Island.

From the South: Take I-35E North to W Kellogg Blvd. exit. Turn right on Kellogg Blvd. and follow Kellogg Blvd. to Wabasha. Turn right onto the Wabasha Street Bridge (the bridge with the rainbow flags on it). Follow the bridge over to the West Side, turn left onto Fillmore Avenue, and turn left on Harriet Island Boulevard (look for the showboat sign). As you begin to follow Harriet Island Boulevard, begin looking for parking as you pass the Trans Park parking lot. Keep driving on Harriet Island Boulevard and you will see the parking lots available for parking. Parking on Raspberry Island during the performances will be limited to Handicap parking and a limited number of musicians and staff who will be bringing their instruments and making deliveries each performance.

Parking can be found in two lots located along Harriet Island Road on Harriet Island. There is a paid parking lot called Trans Park off East Harriet Island Road and East Fillmore Avenue and a paid parking ramp at East Fillmore Ave. and S. Robert St. available. Other parking options include the Victory Ramp in downtown St. Paul and walking partially across the Wabasha Street bridge, taking the stairs down to the island.
