The **ReMembering** film references the [federal law expelling Dakota people from Minnesota and the Dakotas](#) which has never been repealed. In 2009 the Minnesota Legislature passed a [resolution that was transmitted to Congress](#) seeking its repeal, but Republican legislators voted no and [killed it in committee with no discussion](#).

Minnesota's sodomy law [609.293](#) is also still on the books today even through it is now deemed unconstitutional. There have also been unsuccessful attempts to remove it.
