FROM THE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

In March 1989, One Voice Mixed Chorus first performed in public with 38 singers on stage and Cindi Brickson at the helm as Music Director. The chorus performed at the Janet Wallace Auditorium at Macalester College to 200 enthusiastic audience members. What was different in 1988 when One Voice was founded? Not only was there no internet, Wikipedia, or social media— few individuals even owned a personal computer. In 1989, Motorola released a cell phone to rave reviews for its battery life (75 minutes) and price (\$2,995). GPS, Uber, Lyft, Prozac, Nintendo, online shopping, reality TV, and streaming were non-existent.

In 1988, the AIDS epidemic was raging but Ronald Reagan could not say the word "gay". Singers in One Voice left their names out of the concert program for fear of being outed and made an announcement each time a photo was taken so that individuals, especially teachers, would not be

spotted and outed. Parents kept their students home from school when One Voice performed at several schools in greater MN. In 2012 Minnesotans rallied to vote NO to ban marriage for same-sex couples and a year later marriage equality became the law of the land! Through all these changes, One Voice has been out and active in creating a strong community of support for LGBTA individuals, and in creating social change across Minnesota by singing in schools, communities of faith, community events and concerts.

Kudos to you, our audiences, who have supported One Voice through three decades of social change. To you, we offer this celebration of our Roots & Wings!

FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Happy Pride! Welcome to *Roots and Wings* as One Voice celebrates 30 years of making music and creating social change! We're honored and delighted to have you with us.

The world has evolved since One Voice took the stage for the first time. The number one television shows were *The Cosby Show* and *Roseanne* while *The Simpsons* made its debut. "Lost in Your Eyes" by Debbie Gibson was the number one song during a year that also included hits by Madonna ("Like a Prayer"), Bette Midler ("Wind Beneath My Wings"), and Paula Abdul who had three number one hits that year "Straight Up", "Forever Your Girl" and "Cold Hearted." The most popular film of the year was *Batman*. A gallon of gas cost 97 cents. Acid wash jeans, paisley, and big mall hair were the fashion. George H.W. Bush became President of the United States, and the reunification of East Germany and West Germany began. In Denmark, the Registered Partnership Law was passed which granted same sex couples many of the rights and responsibilities of marriage; 12 years before the Netherlands became the first country to allow marriage equality in 2001.



My heartfelt thanks to founder Paul Petrella for his vision, leadership and ongoing support of One Voice; to the founding singers for their incredible courage and perseverance; and to our long-serving Artistic Director, Jane Ramseyer Miller whose energy and creativity never cease to amaze and inspire.

We have made amazing progress in creating social change during 30 years and tonight we celebrate that change as we are reminded how much more work has yet to be done. The great work continues!

Since 1999, One Voice has tackled the problem of bullying and homophobia in our communities through our interactive OUT in Our Schools program. Over the years, we have collaborated with over 50 Minnesota middle and high schools to provide positive LGBT role models and quality music partnerships culminating in joint concerts with our chorus and students performing together. Through this unique program we also support educators and administrators at each participating school with their work building understanding and respect.



OVation is the portable version of One Voice—an a cappella ensemble that brings One Voice's music and message almost anywhere. Since its founding in 2000, OVation has presented over 250 performances, reaching over 30,000 people in dozens of Minnesota communities, at choral festivals from coast to coast, and internationally in Canada and Ireland. OVation performs at 20-30 community engagement events annually, in venues that have included the Minnesota State Fair, the Northern Voice Festival, the Minnesota Arboretum, TwinsFest, several Pride festivals, places of worship, and in partnership with organizations like RECLAIM!, the Aliveness Project, and Avenues for Homeless Youth. One Voice 2018-2019 Season Sneak Peak!



We are excited to announce the appointment of Tesfa Wondemagegnehu as guest conductor for our 2018-2019 season. Newly on the music faculty at St. Olaf College, Tesfa has worked as Director of Choral Ministries at Westminster Presbyterian Church in Minneapolis, as the conductor of The Radio Choir from American Public Media, and as Assistant Artistic Director of VocalEssence.

Our fall season includes a November 3 collaboration with the Minnesota Philharmonic Orchestra, followed by an outreach tour with performances in schools, community centers and churches in Northfield, Willmar and St. Cloud.

In January 2019, audiences will find One Voice at Ted Mann Concert Hall performing music from the stage including Broadway musicals, operettas and opera choruses. Our spring season features the Midwest première of a new commission honoring the 50th anniversary of the Stonewall uprising in NYC. Stonewall50 will be performed as part of One Voice's OUT in Our Schools program, and at the Ordway Concert Hall in June 2019. See the website for dates and details!

During this year, Jane Ramseyer Miller will be on leave and organizing the GALA Choruses LGBT choral festival which will be held in Minneapolis in July 2020 with an anticipated 7,000 queer delegates in attendance!

Jane Ramseyer Miller is in her 23rd year as Artistic Director for One Voice and serves as Artistic Director for GALA Choruses, a national association of LGBT choruses. This winter, she also served as guest Artistic Director for the Twin Cities' Gay Men's Chorus. She holds Masters in Choral Conducting from the University of Minnesota and a BA in Psychology from the University of Waterloo in Ontario, Canada. She enjoys creative community collaborations and has created choral music with The Women's Cancer Resource Center, Shakopee Women's Correctional Facility, In the Heart of the Beast, Kairos Dance Theatre, Mu Daiko, and Teens Rock the Mic among others. In 2008 she received the GALA Choruses Legacy Award for her conducting, innovative programming and commitment to community outreach. In 2010 she was awarded the ACDA VocalEssence Award for Creative Programming and the ACDA Minnesota Advocate for Choral Excellence (ACE) Award.

Paul enjoys a career that spans both classical and popular styles. He has been the guest soloist for several orchestras as well as the accompanist for artists such as singer-songwriter Ann Reed and Las Vegas entertainer and television host Tony Sandler. Kovacovic has concertized across the United States and Czech Republic, and he has won first prizes in the Thursday Musical, Schubert Club, and Indiana University Piano Concerto Competitions. Kovacovic was an accompanist and coach for the Florida Grand Opera in Miami and has also worked with several theater companies in the Twin Cities, including the Minnesota Opera, Ordway Center for the Performing Arts, and Chanhassen Dinner Theatre. Paul loves to teach piano and compose as well as perform. He studied composition in Paris with students of legendary pedagogue Nadia Boulanger and at film scoring workshops in New York, Los Angeles, and Miami. Erik Peregrine is the artistic director of Ensemble Companio, an award-winning New England chamber choir, music director of the Woodbury Chorus & Orchestra, and the assistant conductor for One Voice Mixed Chorus. Peregrine has previously held a diverse array of conducting and teaching positions across North America, including posts with Saint Paul Conservatory for Performing Artists, Vancouver Peace Choir, University of British Columbia Choirs, UBC Symphony Orchestra, and Spiritus Multi-Faith Choir. In demand as a guest clinician and lecturer, he regularly presents on topics related to transgender vocal pedagogy, inclusive rehearsal practices, and LGBTQ+ issues. Originally from the Pacific Northwest, Peregrine earned his Master of Music in choral conducting from the University of British Columbia and his Bachelor of Arts in Music magna cum laude with honors from Lewis & Clark College.

Gary Ruschman is an in-demand performer, conductor, and composer, with singing credits ranging from NPR's *Tiny Desk* concerts to rock bands to the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra. On the podium, Ruschman has led performances for Consortium Carissimi, Blue Waters Brass, Bach Society of Minnesota's *Bach with Friends* baroque retreats, and was chorusmaster for Twin Cities Early Music Festival. Gary currently serves as Director of Music at St. Timothy Lutheran Church in Saint Paul, Mixed Precipitation's *Picnic Operetta*, and is the recent recipient of a Faith Partners composing grant from the American Composers Forum. He was a member of renowned vocal ensemble Cantus for a decade, and a co-recipient of Chorus America's 2011 Education and Community Outreach Award. His education work has included in-school programs for San Francisco Opera, Portland Opera, and more recently Minnesota Opera, who commissioned Gary to create a new children's opera for the Nobles County Integration Collaborative in Worthington, Minnesota.
